Von TRAPP Visit
OCTOBER

2008 275th day - 91 days follow

Was up early & Boxed everything up and when Ernest & Ellie came we put all we needed for Holy Mass in the car and then left for Vermont. It was a nice trip. Many of the trees were in fall color. We did have some rain going up. We went up the trail to find the little chapel built by Werner Von Trapp, one of the original Trapp family singers. Once that was over we went back to the Trapp Lodge. Sam Von Trapp, the grand son of Baron & Maria Von Trapp, his father was Johann the only child of the Baron and his second wife Maria, was very kind and used a small truck (Kubota) to bring us and our material for Holy Mass part way up the trail. We set everything up for Mass. Several couples came up and one couple from Lodi had stayed for Mass. As soon as we were in the chapel it started to rain hard. It rained until the end of Mass and then stopped and didn't start up again until we were back at the lodge.

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
