Dear Ernest Bolduc:

I am writing for the purpose of memorializing the gift of my collection of Far Eastern and Inner Asian books and the conditions associated with the gift.

The library is being transferred to Traditional Catholics of New Hampshire, Inc. in accord with the following provisions:

- a. The collection shall be retained intact and shall not be sold or separated.
- b. The collection shall be properly housed and cared for by Traditional Catholics of New Hampshire, Inc. Major decisions affecting the collection shall be discussed and approved by Father Hector Bolduc, Executor of the Estate of Francis Woodman Cleaves, so long as he serves in that capacity.
- c. Traditional Catholics of New Hampshire, Inc. shall make the collection accessible to scholars and other qualified individuals for research purposes. The collection shall not be loaned out nor removed from the library.
- d. The collection shall be known as the Francis Woodman Cleaves Library of Far Eastern and Inner Asian Studies.
- e. The Corporate Directors of Traditional Catholics of New Hampshire, Inc. shall see to it that the library remains open and always accessible to scholars, and that its maintenance and availability is perpetuated.
- I request that you sign this document, in your capacity as Secretary/Treasurer of Traditional Catholics of New Hampshire, Inc. not only to memorialize my donative intent but also as formal acceptance of the collection for use by other interested persons.
